2. Prepare your art:

All art **must** be ready to hang—mounted on a non-flexible backing with a firm wire or framed and wired. No sticky tape, thumb tacks etc. can be used. The hooks will only work with wire or string. If work is not suitable for hanging, we will not be able to accept it.

3. The artist's name, phone number and school must be clearly printed on the back of each piece of art.

Sculpture is welcome in this show but must be no larger than 24" high and 13" in depth. Sculpture space this year is very limited.

4. Bring your art to the Wilmette Recreation Center on Monday, February 7, 2011, between 4:30 - 6:30 p.m.

Wilmette Arts Guild volunteers will be there to accept your artwork.
Rec center employees are not permitted to accept any artwork.

5. Pick up your art on Monday, March 7, 2011, between 5:00-6:30 p.m.

The Rec Center will not permit pickup at other times. If you are unable to pick up your art in person, please arrange for someone else to do so. Any art not picked up at this time will be disposed of. Rec Center employees are not permitted to release any artwork.
