5. Applicants must DELIVER 2 pieces of fine art work (which may include sculpture) to the **Committee** at the Wilmette Community Recreation Center on Monday, Feb 7, 2011, between 4:30 and 7:30 PM. Your 2 works will be displayed for 1 month (until Monday, March 7, 2011) in the Wilmette Arts Guild Annual Student Art Show held at the Wilmette Community Recreation Center. The Scholarship Committee will make its final decision from the art works which appear in this show. Scholarship applicants must adhere to the Student Art Show guidelines and instructions, and the application for the Student Art Show must be included in your scholarship application envelope.
6. The winner of the \$1,000 Wilmette Arts Guild Fine Art Scholarship will be announced at 7:00 PM during the Student Art Show Reception, which will be held at the Wilmette Community Recreation Center on Thursday, February 17, 2011, from 6:30 to 8:00 PM. We urge all applicants and their parents and friends to attend!
7. Scholarship applicants (and all other Student Art Show participants) must PICK UP their artwork at the Wilmette Community Recreation Center on Monday, March 7, 2011, between 5:00 and 6:30 PM.
